A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **February 9, 2022 at 9:00 am, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard**, at the following location: **Residence Inn Tallahassee Universities at the Capitol, 600 West Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32304.**

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

**If you are the Respondent**, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are the Complainant**, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

**If you are an Appellant**, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

**SUMMARY:** Central Florida Leadership Fund is a political committee (PC) registered with the State of Florida. The PC's chair is Jeremy Sisson and its treasurer is Matthew McMillan.

The PC is appealing the fine claiming that a timely waiver was filed on November 10, 2020. According to the treasurer, Matthew McMillan, the report was amended on December 10, 2020. He realized while filing the M11 report that a \$50 check, dated October 30th, was omitted from the M10 reporting period. He states that check was issued to pay a previous fine and that the check did not post to the online bank account until November 10th. He states that he amended the report to reflect "when it was mailed instead of when the check was received".

- The 2020 M10 Original Report covers the period from 10/30/20-10/31/20; it was due on 11/10/20.
- The 2020 M10 Queued Transaction Report shows that it was created and filed on 11/10/20.<sup>1</sup>
- Central Florida Leadership Fund reported receiving zero contributions, while making 1 expenditure.
- FEC staff was advised, "The committee filed a notice of no activity (waiver) on 11/10/20. A waiver is not a report. On 12/10/20, the committee filed a report showing \$50.00 of activity. The fine is based on 25% of the activity.
- The Division of Elections does not have any notes that pertain to Central Florida Leadership Fund's 2020 M10 report.

I am appealing the fine for \$12.50 to Central Florida Leadership Fund for late filing of the report Due Nov 10 2020.


Contrary to the attached letter a timely waiver was filed on Nov 10, 2020 for the M10 report which covered the two days 10/30-10/31. At the time I thought that there had been no transactions. The attached screen shot from EFS shows a filing date of 11/10 for the M10 report, not the 12/10 alleged in the fine letter.

The M10 Report was amended on Dec 10, 2020 as I prepared the M11 report because I realized that there was one missing transaction. The omitted transaction was the payment of a previous fine of \$50 by check dated October 30. At the time of the filing on November 10<sup>th</sup> I must have forgotten that I had immediately mailed a check for the previous fine in that two day period of the M10 Report. The returned check did not post to the online bank account until November 10<sup>th</sup>. likely after I filed the waiver.

I believe that it was proper to amend the report from when the check was mailed rather than put the check on the M11 when the check was received. I corrected the oversight at soon as it was detected. There was no deception of the public attempted or even accomplished. The only transaction involved was fine. The payment of that fine was public record on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. On November 10<sup>th</sup> a member of the public could ascertain that there was a fine and that it was paid. The error was regarding whether that payment belong on the M10 due November 10<sup>th</sup> or the M11 report due December 10<sup>th</sup>.

Because a report was timely filed, and the erroneously omitted information was otherwise disclosed to the public by the due date, I request that the \$12.50 fine be abated.
