#### **ORDER OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

**THIS MATTER** was heard by the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 14, 2024, in Tallahassee, Florida.

On February 26, 2024, Staff recommended to the Commission that there was probable cause to believe that the Florida Election Code was violated. The facts articulated in Staff's Recommendation are adopted by reference and incorporated herein. Based on the Complaint, Report of Investigation, Staff's Recommendation, and oral statements (if any) made at the probable cause hearing, the Commission finds that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with the following violations:

#### Count 1:

On January 26, 2021, Caneste Succe violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 G4 Report.

#### Count 2:

On January 26, 2021, Caneste Succe violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 G5 Report.

#### Count 3:

On January 26, 2021, Caneste Succe violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 G6 Report.

#### Count 4:

On February 3, 2021, Caneste Succe violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2021 Termination Report.

The Commission finds that there is **no probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Sections 106.07(5), 106.07(7), and 106.141(1), Florida Statutes.



If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(c), Florida Statutes, undersigned staff counsel files this written recommendation for disposition of the sworn complaint in this case recommending that there is **probable cause** to charge Respondent with violating Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, and no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Sections 106.07(5), 106.07(7), and 106.141(1), Florida Statutes. Based upon a thorough review of the Report of Investigation submitted on July 6, 2023, the following facts and law support this staff recommendation:

- 1. On March 15, 2021, the Florida Elections Commission ("Commission") received a sworn complaint from Amber Sacks, Candidate Department Manager for the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections ("Complainant" or "Filing Officer"), alleging that Caneste Succe ("Respondent") violated Chapter 106, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)<sup>1</sup> Respondent was defeated in the general election held on November 3, 2020. (ROI, page 1, ¶1; Attachment A, pages 1-2)
- 3. Respondent's Statement of Candidate form ("DS-DE 84") and Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository form ("DS-DE 9") were filed on August 23, 2019. (ROI Exhibits 1 & 2) Respondent appointed himself to serve as treasurer for the campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1, page 1) On February 13, 2020, Respondent appointed Erica Enriquez to serve as treasurer and himself to serve as deputy treasurer for the campaign. (ROI Exhibit 1, pages 2-3)
- 4. By letter dated April 30, 2021, the Executive Director notified Respondent that Commission staff would investigate the following statutory provisions:

**Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes**: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not, based upon a surplus balance after the notification of no activity for the 2021 termination reporting period was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the following reporting periods:

• 2020 G4

• 2020 G6

• 2020 G5

• 2021 TR

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, filed a notification of no activity for the 2021 termination reporting period that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, based upon a surplus balance after the notification of no activity for the 2021 termination reporting period was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, based upon a surplus balance after the notification of no activity for the 2021 termination reporting period was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

- 5. On August 23, 2019, Respondent signed a Notice of Publications wherein Respondent acknowledged that he could find all campaign publications on the Division of Elections' website. Respondent acknowledged that he read and received the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook*, Compilation of Election Laws, and Election Dates and Activities. (ROI Exhibit 3, page 1) Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate on the same date wherein he certified that he was provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes. (ROI Exhibit 2, page 1)
- 6. The Filing Officer attested that reminders were sent to Respondent prior to each reporting period and that she spoke to Respondent on several occasions about late reports over the phone and in person. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 3) The Filing Officer provided Respondent with the Calendar of Reporting Dates. (ROI Exhibit 4, pages 3 & 5)
- 7. The Filing Officer provided a screenshot of the candidate finance login page with her affidavit. The login page stated that all candidates are required to disclose detailed financial records of all campaign contributions and expenditures in the campaign finance reports. Candidates are informed that a waiver of the report must be filed even if no activity occurred during the reporting period. The login page contained a warning that stated, "It is your responsibility to ensure that campaign reports are accurate, complete and comply with all laws and regulations regarding campaign finance." (ROI Exhibit 4, page 3; ROI Exhibit 5, page 1)

#### Alleged Violations: Sections 106.07(5), 106.07(7), and 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes

8. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to notify the Filing Officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed for the 2020 G4, 2020 G5, 2020 G6, and 2021 Termination reporting periods. Alternatively, Complainant alleged that Respondent certified that the campaign's 2020 G4, 2020 G5, 2020 G6, and 2021 Termination Reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not and that Respondent falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, in the relevant reports.

#### 2020 G4 Report

- 9. The 2020 G4 Report was due on October 9, 2020, and covered the period from September 19, 2020, to October 2, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5) On January 26, 2021, Respondent notified the Filing Officer that he had no campaign activity during the relevant reporting period. The notice of no activity was 109 days late. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 1)
- 10. The requirement under Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, to certify as to the correctness of a report does not apply to notifications of no activity submitted to the filing officer pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.
- 11. It does not appear that Respondent certified the campaign's 2020 G4 Report as true, correct, and complete when it was not because Respondent filed a notice of no activity, which waived the report.
- 12. As to Respondent either filing a late notice of no activity or deliberately failing to include information in the 2020 G4 Report, a subpoena was issued to Respondent's designated campaign depository to identify the campaign's financial activity. Respondent's bank records show one unreported bank fee totaling \$17.00. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 6)
- 13. Respondent acknowledged that some filings were not timely filed. Respondent stated that his campaign treasurer left the campaign, and his campaign consultant took over the treasurer's duties so that Respondent could focus on his campaign. Respondent stated that he relied on the expertise and help of others. Respondent stated that he did not know bank fees were required to be reported as expenditures. Respondent acquired elections experience while running for office in 2002, 2003, 2012, 2016, 2017, and 2020. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 2) Respondent acknowledged that he attended a campaign training class and read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 3)
- 14. It appears that Respondent improperly submitted a notice of no activity for the 2020 G4 reporting period pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, as the campaign had reportable financial activity. Therefore, Respondent deliberately failed to include information in the 2020 G4 Report.

#### 2020 G5 Report

15. The 2020 G5 Report was due on October 23, 2020, and covered the period from October 3, 2020, to October 16, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5) On January 26, 2021, Respondent

notified the Filing Officer that he had no campaign activity during the relevant reporting period. The notice of no activity was 95 days late. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 2)

- 16. The requirement under Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, to certify as to the correctness of a report does not apply to notifications of no activity submitted to the filing officer pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.
- 17. It does not appear that Respondent certified the campaign's 2020 G5 Report as true, correct, and complete when it was not because Respondent filed a notice of no activity, which waived the report.
- 18. As to Respondent either filing a late notice of no activity or deliberately failing to include information in the 2020 G5 Report, Respondent's bank records show one contribution from Boynton Beach Medical Center totaling \$250.00. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 5 & 10)
- 19. Respondent stated that his campaign treasurer left the campaign, and his campaign consultant took over the treasurer's duties so that Respondent could focus on his campaign. Respondent stated that he relied on the expertise and help of others. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 2) Respondent had prior elections experience, acknowledged that he attended a campaign class, and read Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. (ROI Exhibit 8, pages 2-3)
- 20. It appears that Respondent improperly submitted a notice of no activity for the 2020 G5 reporting period pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, as the campaign had reportable financial activity. Therefore, Respondent deliberately failed to include information in the 2020 G5 Report.

#### 2020 G6 Report

- 21. The 2020 G6 Report was due on October 30, 2020, and covered the period from October 17, 2020, to October 29, 2020. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5) On January 26, 2021, Respondent notified the Filing Officer that he had no campaign activity during the relevant reporting period. The notice of no activity was 88 days late. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 3)
- 22. The requirement under Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, to certify as to the correctness of a report does not apply to notifications of no activity submitted to the filing officer pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.
- 23. It does not appear that Respondent certified the campaign's 2020 G6 Report as true, correct, and complete when it was not because Respondent filed a notice of no activity, which waived the report.
- 24. As to Respondent either filing a late notice of no activity or deliberately failing to include information in the 2020 G6 Report, Respondent's bank records show two contributions from Paypal totaling \$0.19, one expenditure back to Paypal for \$0.19, and one cash withdrawal totaling \$250.00. (ROI Exhibit 7, page 5)

- 25. Respondent did not specifically comment on the cash withdrawal. Respondent stated that his campaign treasurer left the campaign, and his campaign consultant took over the treasurer's duties so that Respondent could focus on his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 2)
- 26. It appears that Respondent improperly submitted a notice of no activity for the 2020 G6 reporting period pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, as the campaign had reportable financial activity. Therefore, Respondent deliberately failed to include information in the 2020 G6 Report.

#### **2021 Termination Report**

- 27. The 2021 Termination Report was due on February 1, 2021, and covered the period from October 28, 2020, to February 1, 2021. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5; ROI Exhibit 6, page 4) On February 3, 2021, Respondent notified the Filing Officer that he had no campaign activity during the relevant reporting period. The notice of no activity was 2 days late. (ROI Exhibit 6, page 4)
- 28. The requirement under Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes, to certify as to the correctness of a report does not apply to notifications of no activity submitted to the filing officer pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes.
- 29. It does not appear that Respondent certified the campaign's 2021 Termination Report as true, correct, and complete when it was not because Respondent filed a notice of no activity, which waived the report.
- 30. As to Respondent either filing a late notice of no activity or deliberately failing to include information in the 2021 Termination Report, Respondent's bank records show one contribution from Paypal totaling \$4.95 and three bank fees totaling \$51.00. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 13, 16 & 19)
- 31. Respondent stated that his campaign treasurer left the campaign, and his campaign consultant took over the treasurer's duties so that Respondent could focus on his campaign. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 2)
- 32. It appears that Respondent improperly submitted a notice of no activity for the 2021 Termination reporting period pursuant to Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes, as the campaign had reportable financial activity. Therefore, Respondent deliberately failed to include information in the 2021 Termination Report.

#### Alleged Violation: Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes

- 33. Complainant alleged that Respondent violated Florida's election laws by failing to file a termination report that reflected the disposition of all remaining campaign funds.
- 34. On November 3, 2020, Respondent was defeated in the 2020 general election. (Attachment A, page 2) Therefore, Respondent was required to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after being defeated, i.e., February 1, 2021. (ROI Exhibit 4, page 5)

- 35. Bank records show one contribution from Paypal totaling \$4.95 and three bank fees totaling \$51.00. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 13, 16 & 19) The account incurred a deficit upon the imposition of a monthly bank fee on November 2, 2020, which resulted in a balance of -\$6.56. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 13-14) The account remained in a deficit throughout the reporting period and ended with a balance of -\$35.61. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 14, 17, 20 & 22) The account was force closed on March 3, 2021, after the bank credited the account to zero out the deficit. (ROI Exhibit 7, pages 24-25)
- 36. Respondent stated that no money remained in the account at the close of the reporting period. (ROI Exhibit 8, page 2)
- 37. It does not appear that Respondent failed to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after being defeated as the account ended with a deficit balance. The improper acceptance of a contribution and the account's deficit balance is more appropriately charged under section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes.
- 38. "Probable Cause" is defined as reasonable grounds of suspicion supported by circumstances sufficiently strong to warrant a cautious person in the belief that the person has committed the offense charged. *Schmitt v. State*, 590 So. 2d 404, 409 (Fla. 1991). Probable cause exists where the facts and circumstances, of which an [investigator] has reasonably trustworthy information, are sufficient in themselves for a reasonable man to reach the conclusion that an offense has been committed. *Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Favino*, 667 So. 2d 305, 309 (Fla. 1st DCA 1995).
- 39. The facts set forth above show that Respondent was a candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, in the 2020 election. Respondent deliberately failed to include required information on the campaign's 2020 G4, 2020 G5, 2020 G6, and 2021 Termination Reports. It does not appear that Respondent certified the campaign's 2020 G4, 2020 G5, 2020 G6, and 2021 Termination Reports as true, correct, and complete when they were not because Respondent improperly filed notices of no activity. It does not appear that Respondent failed to dispose of the funds on deposit in his campaign account within 90 days after being defeated because of the campaign account's deficit balance.

Based upon these facts and circumstances, I recommend that the Commission find no probable cause to charge Respondent with violating Sections 106.07(5), 106.07(7), and 106.141(1), Florida Statutes, and that the Commission find probable cause to charge Respondent with violating the following:

#### Count 1:

On January 26, 2021, Caneste Succe violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 G4 Report.

#### Count 2:

On January 26, 2021, Caneste Succe violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 G5 Report.

#### Count 3:

On January 26, 2021, Caneste Succe violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2020 G6 Report.

#### Count 4:

On February 3, 2021, Caneste Succe violated Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes, when he deliberately failed to include information required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, on the campaign's 2021 Termination Report.







#### I. Preliminary Information:

- 1. Respondent was a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission; District 7; he was defeated in the general election held on November 3, 2020. Respondent was not a first-time candidate.
- 2. An Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository (DS-DE 9) was filed with the SOE on August 23, 2019. Respondent was appointed as campaign treasurer. On February 13, 2020, two more DS-DE 9s were filed with the SOE appointing Erica Enriquez as campaign treasurer, appointing Respondent as deputy campaign treasurer, and designating a new campaign depository. To review the DS-DE 9s, refer to Exhibit 1.
- 3. Respondent filed a Statement of Candidate with the SOE on August 23, 2019, in which Respondent certified he had been provided access to read and understand the requirements of Chapter 106, F.S. To review the Statement of Candidate, refer to Exhibit 2.
- 4. On August 23, 2019, Respondent signed a Notice of Publications and filed it with the SOE. In the Notice of Publications, Respondent was notified that publications for use during his campaign were available on the Division of Elections' website. By signing the form, Respondent acknowledged that he had read and received written notice of the following publications: *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook, Compilation of Election Laws*, and *Election Dates and Activities*. To review the Notice of Publications, refer to Exhibit 3.
- 5. In an affidavit, Ms. Sacks attested that she spoke to Respondent on several occasions about late reports on the phone and in person and that reminders were sent to Respondent prior to each reporting period. On the candidate/committee finance login page of the SOE's website, candidates are notified that they are required to disclose records of campaign contributions and expenditures in campaign finance reports and that a waiver of report must be filed if there has been no activity during a reporting period. The login page also contained a warning that, "It is your responsibility to ensure that campaign reports are accurate, complete and comply with all laws and regulations regarding campaign finance." To review the affidavit with 2020 Calendar of Reporting Dates, refer to Exhibit 4. To review the SOE's website page, refer to Exhibit 5.

#### II. Alleged Violation of Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes:

6. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not timely notifying the filing officer, in writing, that no report(s) would be filed due to not receiving any contributions or making expenditures during the following reporting period(s): 2020 G4, 2020 G5, 2020 G6, and 2021 TR. Respondent's filing history of untimely filed notifications is summarized below. To review the untimely filed notifications, refer to Exhibit 6.

Although waivers were filed for the reports listed in the above table, bank records indicate there was reportable financial activity during each of those reporting periods.   - 8. Respondent did not respond to the complaint.
- 9. I called Respondent for the purpose of providing an opportunity to discuss the allegations made in the complaint. Respondent acknowledged that waivers were not timely filed. Respondent stated that he relied on the expertise and help of others; he explained that his campaign treasurer left the campaign, and his campaign consultant/manager took over those duties so Respondent could focus on his campaign. When I noted that bank fees found in the records were not reported, Respondent stated he never knew that they were to be reported as expenditures and thanked me for the information. When I asked if he was aware there were contributions/deposits found in the bank records that were not reported, Respondent answered in the negative. Respondent acknowledged reading Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, and the *Candidate & Campaign Treasurer Handbook*. Also, Respondent stated that he attended a training class/workshop. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 8.

#### III. Alleged Violation of Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes:

- 10. I investigated whether Respondent violated this section of the election laws by not disposing of all remaining campaign funds within 90 days of being eliminated.
- 11. On the date the 2021 TR was due, February 1, 2021, campaign account records reflect that the balance was -\$35.61. On March 2, 2021, the bank credited the account \$35.61 in order to zero out and force close the account. The bank specified that the campaign account was closed on March 3, 2021. To review the relevant bank records, refer to Exhibit 7, pages 21-25.
- 12. When I interviewed Respondent, I asked about the apparent surplus balance. Respondent stated there was no money remaining in the account. To review the phone log, refer to Exhibit 8.

#### CANDIDATE/COMMITTEE FINANCE LOGIN

#### Welcome Candidates, Campaign Managers, and Committees!

By Florida law, campaigns, committees, and electioneering communications organizations are required to disclose detailed financial records of campaign contributions and expenditures, also known as "Campaign Finance Reports".

Campaign Finance Reports are required **even if there has been no activity during the reporting period**. In those cases, you are required to file a Waiver of Report. Reports must be filed on or before the due date. Fines for late filing of reports are automatic and must be paid from personal rather than campaign funds. It is your responsibility to ensure that campaign reports are accurate, complete and comply with all laws and regulations regarding campaign finance.



I have reviewed the complaint and find that it contains one or more **legally sufficient allegations**. The Commission staff will investigate the following alleged violations:

Section 106.07(5), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, may have certified one or more campaign treasurer reports were true, correct, and complete when they were not, based upon a surplus balance after the notification of no activity for the 2021 termination reporting period was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

**Section 106.07(7), Florida Statutes**: As alleged in the complaint, Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, failed to notify the filing officer on the prescribed reporting date that no report would be filed on that date because he had not received funds, made contributions, or expended reportable funds during the following reporting periods:

Section 106.141(1), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, filed a notification of no activity for the 2021 termination reporting period that may have failed to accurately reflect the disposition of all remaining campaign funds, based upon a surplus balance after the notification of no activity for the 2021 termination reporting period was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

Section 106.19(1)(c), Florida Statutes: Respondent, a 2020 candidate for Palm Beach County Commission, District 7, may have falsely reported or deliberately failed to include information in one or more campaign treasurer reports, as required by Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, based upon a surplus balance after the notification of no activity for the 2021 termination reporting period was filed, as alleged in the complaint.

When we conclude the investigation, a copy of the Report of Investigation (ROI) will be mailed to you at the above address. Based on the results of the investigation, a staff attorney will prepare and present a written Staff Recommendation (SR) to the Commission as to whether there is probable cause to charge you, the Respondent, with violating Chapters 104 or 106, Florida Statutes. You will have an opportunity to respond to both the ROI and the SR. The Commission will then hold one or more hearings to determine whether the alleged violations occurred and, if so, the amount of the fine to be imposed upon you. Notice will be mailed to you and the Complainant at least 14 days before any hearing at which your case is to be considered.

Pursuant to Section 106.25(4)(i)3., Florida Statutes, the Commission may enter into a consent agreement with a Respondent to settle a complaint prior to a finding of probable cause. If you are interested in entering negotiations directed towards reaching a consent agreement to resolve this matter, please contact the Commission and request to speak with the attorney assigned to this case.

However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine is \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. The amount due must be paid within 20 days of the date of receipt of this notice.

Once your report is filed, our office will notify you of the specific amount of your fine. Fines must be paid to the filing officer within 20 days of receipt of the payment due notice.



Your campaign treasurer's G4 report, which was due on 10/9/2020, has not been received.

Section 106.07(8)(b), Florida Statutes, provides a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days a report is late and, thereafter \$500 per day. A fine cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine is \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. The amount due must be paid within 20 days of the date of receipt of this notice.

Once your report is filed, our office will notify you of the specific amount of your fine. Fines must be paid to the filing officer within 20 days of receipt of the payment due notice.

Please be advised, however, that failure to file a campaign treasurer's report may constitute a violation of Chapter 106, Florida Statutes, independent of the automatic fine violation referenced above. Therefore, if you fail to file a report, we will turn the matter over to the Florida Elections Commission.

Section 106.265(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Florida Elections Commission to impose a civil penalty up to \$1,000 per count for each willful violation of Chapter 106.

Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, states that in the case of an unusual circumstance surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, each candidate or committee will have the option to file an appeal with the Florida Elections Commission. It is the responsibility of the candidate or committee to notify the filing officer in writing of his or her intention to submit an appeal. Any such requests shall be made within 20 days after receiving the notice of payment due.
