NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE (AF))

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **April 22, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: via Webinar at: **Registration URL** <https://attendee.gotowebinar.com/register/17181422935246175>, **Webinar ID 325-697-827**.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider an **appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Nari Tomlinson was a candidate for the City of Miramar Commission, Seat 3 in the 2025 elections. Mr. Tomlinson was his own treasurer.

Nari Tomlinson is appealing the fine claiming that the delay in submission was due to circumstances beyond his control, specifically his inability to access the campaign's banking records online, which prevented him from accurately completing the report on time. According to Mr. Tomlinson, he was unexpectedly locked out of his online banking account and was unable to retrieve the necessary financial records required for accurate reporting. He was unable to resolve the issue before the deadline. He requests a waiver of the fine.

- The 2025 G1 Original Report covers the period from 01/01/25-02/07/25; it was due on 02/14/25.
- The 2025 G1 Report shows that it was filed on 02/18/25 at approximately 12:31am.
- Nari Tomlinson reported receiving 33 contributions, while making 4 expenditures.
- The City of Miramar City Clerk's office does not have any notes that pertain to Nari Tomlinson's 2025 G1 report.

Dear Mr. Tomlinson:

This letter serves to inform you that your Campaign Treasurer's Report (2025-G1), which was due on February 14, 2025, was not submitted until February 18, 2025.

Pursuant to Section 106.07(8)(b) of the Florida Statutes, a fine of \$50 per day is applicable for the initial three days that a report is late. Following this period, the fine escalates to \$500 per day. It is important to note that the total fine cannot exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the reporting period in question. Furthermore, for reports that are submitted late in the immediate timeframe preceding primary and general elections, the fine is uniformly set at \$500 per day, also subject to the aforementioned 25% limitation based on total receipts or expenditures.

As your report was deemed filed on February 18, 2025, you are hereby assessed a fine totaling \$650.00. This amount must be remitted to the City of Miramar within 20 days from the date of receipt of this notice unless you choose to appeal to the Florida Elections Commission. Please be reminded that, as a candidate, this fine is not a permissible campaign expenditure and must be paid with personal funds.



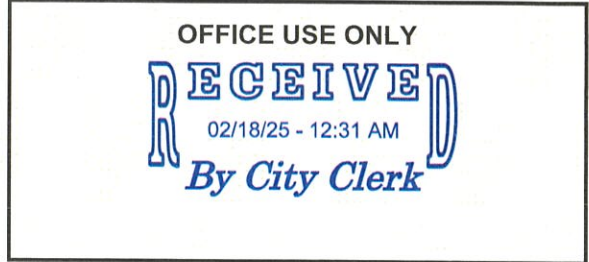

DEADLINES AND PENALTIES

All Campaign Treasurer's Reports MUST be submitted on the deadlines indicated on the reporting schedule to avoid having a fine levied. A fine of \$50 per day can be imposed for the first three (3) days; on the fourth (4th) day, \$500 shall be imposed, pursuant to F. S. 106.07.

Disposal of Campaign Funds

Any candidate who withdraws their candidacy becomes unopposed, is eliminated, or is elected to office shall, within 90 days, dispose of funds on deposit in his/her campaign account and file a TR Report reflecting the disposition of all remaining funds, pursuant to F.S. 106.141.

Please note: All reports required of a candidate shall be filed with the officer before whom the candidate is required by law to qualify. The City Clerk is the qualifying officer for candidates who wish to contend for elected office in the City of Miramar. (Section 106.07 (2) (a) 1.FS)

Chapter 106, Campaign Finance, Florida Statutes governs campaign reporting activities.
