NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE (AF))

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **April 22, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard, at the following location: via Webinar at: **Registration URL** <https://attendee.gotowebinar.com/register/17181422935246175>, **Webinar ID 325-697-827**.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have *5 minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Please refer to the information below for further instructions related to your particular hearing:

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing.* The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: The Honorable Jim Boldt was a candidate for Venice City Council, Seat 4 (Vice-Mayor) in the 2024 elections. Sarah Lee was his treasurer.

Vice Mayor Jim Boldt is appealing the fine. According to Sarah Lee, campaign treasurer, on the evening of October 26th, "Mr. Boldt collapsed at the Venice Yacht Club, suffering from heart and blood pressure issues." She notes that he was admitted to the cardiac ward and hospitalized for multiple issues until October 28th. Ms. Lee claims that the report was prepared but could not be submitted until the final bank expenditures were posted on November 1st. She also notes that Mr. Boldt could not submit the report due to a procedure on November 1, 2024. Medical documents have been provided with the appeal. They request a waiver of the fine due to the circumstances.

- The 2024 G6 Original Report covers the period from 10/19/24-10/31/24; it was due on 11/01/24.
- The 2024 G6 Report shows that it was filed on 11/04/24.
- Jim Boldt reported receiving 40 contributions, while making 4 expenditures.
- The Venice City Clerk's office provided notes that pertain to Jim Boldt's 2024 G6 report.

Dear Braxton,

I appreciate your time today explaining the process for appeal. Attached are some supporting documents for the appeal and the fine notice received from the Venice City Clerk's Office yesterday. Kelly Michaels

Jim Boldt is up for re election for seat 4 on Venice City Council.

As treasurer for his campaign, every report has been submitted well ahead of time since April when he first decided to re run. I am a part time employee for the Boldt's working Tuesday and Thursday, I work for another Company on the opposing days.

On Saturday Evening, 26th of October, Jim Boldt Collapsed at the Venice Yacht Club, suffering from Heart and Blood pressure issues. An ambulance was called and he was rushed to SMH Venice where it was determined he needed further critical care at SMH Sarasota. He was transfere to Sarasota via ambulance and admitted to the Cardiac ward.

It was determined he was suffering from Atrial Fibrillation, Acute Kindney Injury, serious blood pressure fluctuations and blood loss from a large laceration from a wound created when he fell.

Jim was hospitalized until the evening of Monday October 28th, When they finally discharged him to go home. The hospital had managed to stabilize the blood pressure, but he was still in Afib and serious pain from his now stitched up wound. They released him with a new regimen of drugs of which he needed to start right away.

As requested by his Doctors he needed to rest, and monitor blood pressure, due to the risk of stroke due to the afib which needed to be stopped by performing another procedure, later in the week. This was scheduled at 7 am, Friday the 1st of November at SMH Sarasota, at 7 am. This procedure was completed under anasthesia.

In the iterim, I (treasurer) had prepared the treasurers report, but had to wait for the final expenditure (Bank Service Fees) and income, (Bank Interest) to post to the account, which you dont see on the online statement until the 1st of each month. The following day was Friday November 1st, I was at my other employers from 9am - 5 pm. On the same day, November 1st, Jim and his wife left to go to Sarasota Memorial at 6am, for the procedure They did not return until mid afternoon.

As you can see there was alot going on, the candidates health is of primary concern, it was very

worrying for everyone for a time, we have managed to get his heart stabilized and back in rhythm. As treasurer, i could not be there to submit due to my other employment. Jim was not well enough in the afternoon to be able to submit.

I will have further supporting documents to submit to you, I am waiting for the surgeons RN to confirm the November 1st procedure.

Please let me know if there is anything more you need, other than supporting docs, which i will follow up with

Dear Mr. Boldt:

The Florida Elections Commission received a letter from *Sarah Lee* appealing the fine assessed against you for failing to timely file a required report. However, Section 106.07(8)(c), Florida Statutes, provide that only the ***candidate or chair*** of a political committee, may appeal a fine assessed by a filing officer for the late filing of a campaign treasurer's report.

Therefore, to preserve your right to appeal the automatic fine, the Commission must receive your written statement confirming that the person who submitted the initial intent to appeal the fine, was representing you in that request. For your convenience, your signed statement can be submitted via email attachment to, FEC@myfloridalegal.com.

In addition, Rules 2B-1.005 and 2B-1.0055, Florida Administrative Code, are the Commission's rules governing the appeal of automatic fines; a copy of the rules is enclosed. Pursuant to Rule 2B-1.005(1)(a)-(c), the following required information is missing from your request for appeal:

- **The address and telephone number of the appealing party**

If we do not hear from you within 14 days from the date of this letter, we will assume that the person signing the letter is neither your attorney nor your personal representative and that you have waived your right to appeal. The Commission will then enter a Default Final Order, ordering you to pay the fine assessed by your filing officer for failing to timely file your campaign treasurer's report.

I urge your immediate attention to this matter.

2B-1.005 Appeal of Fines Imposed by Filing Officers.

(1) To appeal a fine imposed pursuant to section 106.04(8) or 106.07(8), F.S., the party against whom the fine is levied shall file a notice of appeal with the Commission, and a copy filed with the filing officer, within 20 days of the appealing party's receipt of notice that a fine is being imposed. The notice of appeal shall contain:

(a) The name, address and telephone number of the appealing party;

(b) A copy of the notice of imposition of fine issued by the filing officer; and,

(c) A request for hearing if a personal appearance before the Commission is desired. If no hearing request is made, the appeal shall be decided solely on the documents submitted by the appealing party and Commission staff.

(2) Upon receipt of a timely notice of appeal, the Commission staff shall notify the appealing party that the appeal has been accepted. The appealing party shall have 20 days from acceptance of the appeal to submit any documents supporting the appeal. Any subsequent supplemental documents shall be filed no later than five business days before the hearing.

(3) The Commission shall uphold the fine imposed by the filing officer unless the appealing party demonstrates that the report was timely filed or that there were unusual or other circumstances beyond the control of the candidate or committee that caused the report to be filed late.

Discharge Instructions for Cardioversion

Your healthcare provider

Home care

So you won't be able to drive home. You will need a ride. Wait at least 24 hours before driving a car or operating heavy machinery after getting sedating medicines.

- The skin on your chest may be irritated or feel like it's sunburned. Your healthcare provider may prescribe a soothing lotion or medicine to ease this discomfort. These minor symptoms will go away in a few days.

for at least 4 weeks after the procedure.

Be sure you discuss which medicine you are taking to Ask if you need to have your medicine levels checked and when. Also ask if you can stop taking the medicine in the future or if you need to take it for life

medicines or foods. Your healthcare team will give you full instructions on what to watch out for. Report bleeding or symptoms of stroke right away to your healthcare team and seek emergency medical attention.

- Learn to take your own pulse. Keep a record of your results. Ask your healthcare provider when you should seek emergency medical attention. They will tell you which pulse rate reading is dangerous.
- If you were prescribed take it as instructed by your healthcare provider. These medicines may help prevent your opening again. You may need After the procedure, your healthcare provider will tell you if the treatment worked or if you will need further treatments or medicine.

Follow-up care

Make a follow-up appointment, or as advised.

When to call your healthcare provider

Call your healthcare provider right away if you:

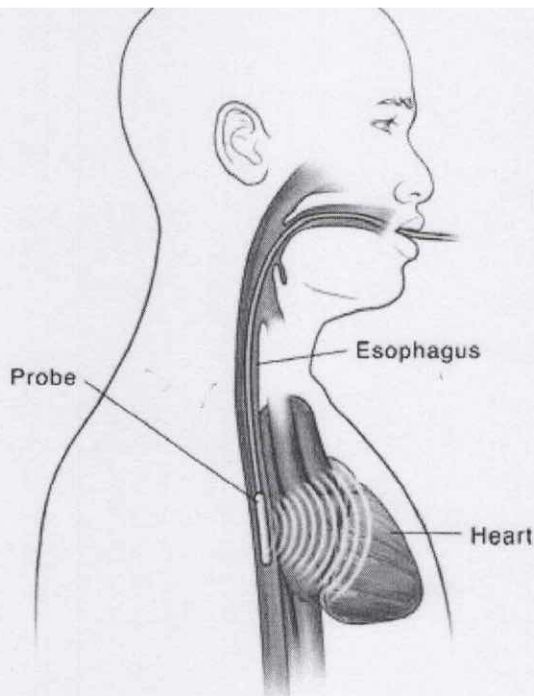
- Feel faint, dizzy, or lightheaded
- Have chest pain with increased activity
- Have irregular heartbeat or fast pulse
- Have bleeding issues from blood-thinning medicines

Call 911

Call 911 right away if you have:

- Chest pain
- Shortness of breath
- Loss of vision, speech, or strength or coordination in any body part

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A probe in your esophagus produces sound waves.

Before your test

- Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take. Ask if you should take them before the test. Your stomach typically should be empty for this test to prevent vomiting, so your provider will likely tell you not to take them.
- Follow any directions you're given for not eating or drinking before the procedure.
- Tell your provider if you have ulcers, a hiatal hernia, or problems swallowing. Also report a history of narrowing of the esophagus, or any other past gastrointestinal problems. A smaller probe may be needed for your study.
- Let the provider know of any allergies to medicines or sedatives.
- Also let them know if you have dental implants or dentures that should be removed before the test.
- Arrange to have someone drive you home after the exam. You'll be given a sedative for

the test. It won't be safe to drive for a period of time.

During your TEE

- When you arrive for your TEE, you'll change into a hospital gown, and then be taken to the testing room.
- Your provider will spray your throat with a numbing medicine. You may be given a medicine through an IV (intravenous) line in your arm to help you relax. You may also be given oxygen. Then you'll be asked to lie on your left side.
- The healthcare provider gently puts the small, lubricated probe into your mouth. A small plastic or rubber bite-block will be put in your mouth to prevent you from biting down on the probe during the test. As you swallow, the provider will slowly guide the tube into your esophagus.
- You may feel the healthcare provider moving the probe. But it shouldn't hurt or interfere with your breathing. A nurse checks your heart rate, blood pressure, and breathing. The test usually takes about 15 minutes.
- The nurse or assistant will suction any saliva out of your mouth, similar to when you have a dental cleaning.

After the test

- Tell your healthcare provider about any pain. Let them know if you cough up or vomit blood, or have trouble swallowing.
- Your throat may be sore for a few hours. You can eat and drink again when your throat is no longer numb and you're fully awake.
- Don't drive a car or run heavy machinery for at least 24 hours after getting sedation. Most people can return to normal activities after 24 hours. Ask your healthcare provider when it's safe for you to return to normal activities.
- Keep your follow-up appointment to go over the results with your healthcare provider.

Calculation of Fine for Late Campaign Treasurer's Report

DE Reference Guide 0013 (eff. 12/2014)

These guidelines are for reference only. They are not to be construed as legal advice or representation. For any particular set of facts or circumstances, refer to the applicable state, federal law, and case law, and/or consult a private attorney before drawing any legal conclusions or relying upon this information.

WHAT IS A FILING OFFICER'S DUTIES REGARDING FINES?

- Notify immediately, as applicable, the candidate, chair of the political committee, the electioneering communication organization, or chair of the political party executive committee that the candidate, committee or organization has failed to file a campaign finance report by the applicable due date and that a fine is being assessed for each late day. (See Sections 106.07(8)(b), 106.0703(7)(b), and 106.29(3)(b), F.S.)
- Determine the late fine amount and notify the applicable person or entity.
 - The fine is due to the filing officer within 20 days after receipt of the notice of payment, unless an appeal is made to the Florida Elections Commission.
- Has no authority to waive the fine regardless of the reason – only the Florida Elections Commission has that authority.
- Must report to the Florida Elections Commission any repeated late filings, the failure to file a report after notice, and a failure to pay the fine.

HOW IS THE TYPE OF REPORT, ENTITY, AND FINE RATE DETERMINED?

- **Candidate, political committee (PC), or electioneering communication organization (ECO)**
 - Reports due immediately preceding an election: \$500 for each day late.
 - Termination reports: \$50 for each day late (Only candidates file "termination" reports. PCs and ECOs file their final activity in the next regularly scheduled report after the PC/ECO notice of termination is filed with the filing officer).
 - All other reports: \$50 for the first 3 days, \$500 each day thereafter.
- **State executive committees and affiliated party committees**
 - Reports due immediately preceding an election: \$10,000 for each day late.
 - All other reports: \$1,000 for each day late.
- **County Executive Committees**
 - Reports due immediately preceding an election: \$500 for each day late.
 - All other reports: \$50 for each date late.

HOW IS THE NUMBER OF "LATE" DAYS CALCULATED? (SEE [DE 91-07](#) AND EXAMPLES ON NEXT PAGE)

- The first late day **begins** on the day after the campaign treasurer's report is due.
- The number of days late includes **weekends and holidays**.
- The last late day **ends** on (and includes) the earliest of the date:
 - The filing officer receives the report
 - The report is postmarked
 - A certificate shows mailed
 - An established courier company's receipt shows received, or
 - An electronic filing system shows received.

HOW IS THE FINE CALCULATED?

- **STEP 1:** Calculate the fine based upon the Daily Method, i.e.,
 - Multiply the number of days late by the appropriate fine rate.
- **STEP 2:** Calculate the fine based upon the Percentage Method, i.e.,
 - Review expenditures and contributions in the report in question.
 - Multiple the **greater** of the two by 25% (i.e., by .25).
- **STEP 3:** Compare the fine amounts calculated using the Daily Method versus the Percentage Method.
- **STEP 4:** The amount of the fine will be the **lesser** of the two calculated amounts.

EXAMPLES

- **#1 – Fine for Candidate – Report not due immediately preceding an election and not a termination report**
 - Report was 4 days late
 - Expenditures = \$10,000; Contributions = \$20,000
 - Calculation of fine using daily method – 3 days x \$50 per day + 1 day at \$500 per day = \$650
 - Calculation of fine using percentage method - \$20,000 x 25% = \$5000
 - Fine to be imposed = \$650

- **#2 – Fine for Candidate, Political Committee, Electioneering Communication Organization, or County Executive Committee - Report due immediately preceding an election**
 - Report was 5 days late
 - Expenditures = \$40,000; Contributions = \$0
 - Calculation of fine using daily method – 5 days x \$500 per day = \$2,500
 - Calculation of fine using percentage method - \$40,000 x 25% = \$10,000
 - Fine to be imposed = \$2,500

- **#3 – Fine for Candidate - Termination report**
 - Report was 5 days late
 - Expenditures = \$10,000
 - Calculation of fine using daily method – 5 days x \$50 per day = \$250
 - Calculation of fine using percentage method - \$10,000 x 25% = \$2,500
 - Fine to be imposed = \$250

- **#4 - Fine for County Executive Committee – Report not due immediately preceding an election**
 - Report was 2 days late
 - Expenditures = \$10,000; Contributions = \$12,000
 - Calculation of fine using daily method – 2 days x \$50 per day = \$100
 - Calculation of fine using percentage method - \$12,000 x 25% = \$3,000
 - Fine to be imposed = \$100

- **#5 – Fine for Political Committee or Electioneering Communication Organization – Report not due immediately preceding an election**
 - Report was 10 days late
 - Expenditures = \$10,000; Contributions = \$12,000
 - Calculation of fine using daily method – 3 days x \$50 per day + 7 days x \$500 per day = \$3,650
 - Calculation of fine using percentage method - \$12,000 x 25% = \$3,000
 - Fine to be imposed = \$3,000
