NOTICE OF HEARING (AUTOMATIC FINE (AF))

A hearing will be held in this case before the Florida Elections Commission on, **November 14, 2023 at 8:30 a.m.**, *or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard*, at the following location: **402 South Monroe Street**, **12 HOB**, **Tallahassee**, **Florida 32399.** Due to heightened security access requirements, please bring only essential items into the building and plan to arrive early to allow for delays coming through security.

Failure to appear in accordance with this notice will constitute a waiver of your right to participate in the hearing. Continuances will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

This hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.25, Florida Statutes, which governs your participation as follows:

If you are the Respondent, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 minutes to present your case to the Commission. However, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless you request to be heard or the Commission requests that your case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, your case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are the Complainant, you may attend the hearing, but you will *not* be permitted to address the Commission. In addition, some cases (including those in which consent orders or recommendations for no probable cause are being considered) may be decided by an *en masse* vote and, unless the Respondent requests to be heard or the Commission requests that the case be considered separately on the day of the hearing, the case will *not* be individually heard.

If you are an Appellant, and you have requested a hearing, you may attend the hearing, and you or your attorney will have 5 *minutes* to present your case to the Commission.

Please be advised that both confidential and public cases are scheduled to be heard by the Florida Elections Commission on this date. As an Appellant, Respondent or Complainant in one case, you will *not* be permitted to attend the hearings on other confidential cases.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

If this is a hearing to consider **an appeal from an automatic fine**, the Filing Officer has imposed a fine on you for your failure to file a campaign treasurer's report on the designated due date and, by filing an appeal, you have asked the Commission to consider either (1) that the report was in fact timely filed; or (2) that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure to file the report timely. You are required to prove your case. If the Commission finds that the report was filed timely or that there were unusual circumstances that excused the failure, it may waive the fine, in whole or in part. The Commission may reduce a fine after considering the factors in Section 106.265, Florida Statutes. If the Commission finds that the report was not timely filed and there were no unusual circumstances, the fine will be upheld.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order before a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed and become public. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the case will remain confidential, unless confidentiality has been waived.

If this is a hearing to consider a **consent order after a determination of probable cause has been made**, the Commission will decide whether to accept or reject the consent order. If the Commission accepts the consent order, the case will be closed. If the Commission rejects the consent order or does not make a decision to accept or deny the consent order, the Respondent will be entitled to another hearing to determine if the Respondent committed the violation(s) alleged.

If this is a **probable cause hearing**, the Commission will decide if there is probable cause to believe that the Respondent committed a violation of Florida's election laws. Respondent should be prepared to explain how the staff in its recommendation incorrectly applied the law to the facts of the case. *Respondent may not testify, call others to testify, or introduce any documentary or other evidence at the probable cause hearing*. The Commission will only decide whether Respondent should be *charged* with a violation and, before the Commission determines whether a violation has occurred or a fine should be imposed, Respondent will have an opportunity for another hearing at which evidence may be introduced.

If this is an **informal hearing**, it will be conducted pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes; Chapter 28 and Commission Rule 2B-1.004, Florida Administrative Code. At the hearing, the Commission will decide whether the Respondent committed the violation(s) charged in the Order of Probable Cause. The Respondent will be permitted to testify. However, the Respondent may not call witnesses to testify.

Respondent may argue why the established facts in the Staff Recommendation do not support the violations charged in the Order of Probable Cause. At Respondent's request, the Commission may determine whether Respondent's actions in the case were willful. The Respondent may also address the appropriateness of the recommended fine. If Respondent claims that his limited resources make him unable to pay the statutory fine, *he must provide the Commission with written proof of his financial resources* at the hearing. A financial affidavit form is available from the Commission Clerk.

SUMMARY: Angelica D. Xenes-Pacheco was a candidate for Hialeah City Council, Group 6, in the 2021 elections. Ms. Xenes-Pacheco was her own treasurer.

Angelica D. Xenes-Pacheco is appealing the fine claiming she was very ill during the campaign and made efforts to comply. According to Ms. Xenes-Pacheco, she became sick with COVID and was initially hospitalized for two weeks and readmitted multiple times due to complications. She claims that "due to the steroids administered in the hospital, [she] developed Exogenous Cushing Syndrome and was unable to walk for many weeks." She notes that family and friends helped deliver reports.

- The 2021 G3 Original Report covers the period from 10/16/21-10/28/21; it was due on 10/29/21.
- The 2021 G3 Report shows that it was filed on 11/01/21 at 11:06 a.m.
- Angelica D. Xenes-Pacheco reported receiving 1 contribution while making 2 expenditures.
- The City of Hialeah Clerk's office does not have any notes that pertain to Angelica D Xenes-Pacheco's 2021 G3 Report.

RE: Response to Case No.: FEC 22-371

To whom it may concern,

I received a notice of complaint from the Florida Elections Commission on January 19, 2023 (tracking# 9214 8969 0099 9790 1645 7697 62) which was hand delivered to my address by a neighbor who states that the envelope was mistakenly delivered to their house which has the same number as mine but on a different street.

That same day I opened the envelope and saw it was dated December 22, 2022. I sent an email to <u>fec@myfloridalegal.com</u> notifying the delayed delivery and to request time to respond which was granted. (EXHIBIT 1)

I have reviewed the alleged violations and respond as follows:

Alleged Violation #1

-2021 G1 Campaign Treasurer Report due Friday October 8, 2021was delivered Wednesday October 13, 2021

-Failure to pay fine for late report.

The complaint states that the report was hand delivered by Yuri Yanes on October 13, 2021. According to the report, a letter of late filing and assessed fine addressed to the candidate was given to Mr. Yuri Yanes.

Yuri Yanes had the report in his possession on the morning of the due date. I was not aware that the report was filed late. Yuri Yanes did not give me the notice of late filing and assessed fine.

Upon reading the complaint I saw that notices were sent by email. I did not see the emails until today after I searched for them and found them in the SPAM folder. (EXHIBIT 2)

The complaint states that 2 attempts to notify me via certified mail were unsuccessful because the mail was returned to sender as unclaimed. Allegedly third certified letter was delivered on January 28, 2022.

There is no one home throughout the day to receive and sign for mail. The third letter was not received either. Tracking number 70142870000127951572 shows as Delivered, Left with Individual, but that is not possible since there was no one to receive it. The mail was not received. There have been ongoing issues with certified mail. I have gone to the post office in the past regarding this problem. I now went to file a formal complaint and the supervisor, Mr. Vargas instructed me to fill out the online form. (**EXHIBIT 3**)

I became sick with COVID during the campaign and was initially hospitalized for 2 weeks. I was readmitted multiple times due to complications. Due to the steroids that were administered in the hospital, I developed Exogenous Cushing Syndrome and was unable to walk for many weeks. Friends and family helped me with delivering the reports during this time.

I was not aware that the 2021 G1 report was delivered late or that a fine was due. Email notifications were not seen because they went to the SPAM folder. Letters sent by mail were not received. I spoke with the City Clerks office on or around January 26th 2022, and I was not informed of the 2021-G1 late filing and fee.

Alleged Violation #2

-2021-G3 Campaign Treasurer Report due Friday October 29, 2021, was delivered Monday November 1, 2021

-Failure to pay fine for late report.

The report was given to Reina Guanche before the due date but she arrived too late to City Hall Friday October 29th 2021. Reina Guanche delivered it the next business day which was Monday November 1, 2021. Reina did inform me that there was a late fine assessed. I did not receive any notification via mail. A formal complaint has been filed with the USPS for mail that shows as delivered but was never received. (**EXHIBIT 4**) Notifications sent via email were not seen until now due to going to the SPAM folder (**EXHIBIT 3**)

During a telephone conversation January 2022, with an employee at the City Clerks office, I was reminded of the late fine. I sent multiple money orders in February 2022 and to my understanding, this fine was paid in full.

Alleged Violation #3

Late Filing of 2021-R2 Campaign Treasurers Report

During a telephone conversation with an employee at the City Clerks office on or around January 26th 2022, I was informed that the 2021-R2 Campaign treasurers report was filed late. I was not aware that a fine was due prior to that date. By the time I found out about the fine, it was too late to file an appeal with the FEC. I would have requested a reduction of the fine due to the circumstances with my medical condition that required me to rely on help during that time. Nevertheless, I sent the payment for the \$2,737.50 fine on February 2, 2022. Emails were not seen because they went to the SPAM folder (**EXHIBIT3**). No mail was received. A complaint has been filed with the USPS due to an ongoing problem with certified mail (**EXHIBIT 5**)

Alleged Violation #4

Late Filing TR (Termination Report) Campaign Treasurers Report and failure to pay the fine imposed.

Report due February 14, 2022, Delivered February 16, 2022.

I was not aware that the report was late or that a fine was due. A complaint has been filed with the USPS due to mail delivery problems.

I have addressed all issues and paid fines for which I have been made aware of. There have been ongoing problems with mail delivery to my address since 2020. I have made several complaints to the USPS. The supervisor at the post office informed me that during 2020 and part of 2021, mail carriers were not required to deliver certified mail directly to an individual as a COVID precaution, yet multiple mail pieces show as delivered, left with individual. This has been a problem with all certified mail and packages requiring signature, not just with mail from City of Hialeah. One of the letters show as left with Front Desk/Reception even though there is no front desk since it is a house. Another one shows left with individual even though no one was home on that date/time. I would not have intentionally disregarded a notice requiring my attention. On January 26th 2022 I was verbally informed of the late filing of 2021-R2 Campaign Treasurers Report and I sent the \$2,737.50 payment for the fine within one week. I will contact the City Clerk to address any pending fines. I was not aware of the \$1,150.00 due for late 2021-G1 Report. All emails from City of Hialeah went to SPAM. If there is any possibility of waiving or reducing the amount of the outstanding fine, I kindly ask you to please review the circumstances and make a determination. I was very ill during that year and made my best effort to be in compliance.



Per section 106.07(2)(a)1. All reports required of a candidate by this section shall be filed with the officer before whom the candidate is required by law to qualify. All candidates who file with the Department of State shall file their reports pursuant to s. 106.0705. Except as provided in s. 106.0705, reports shall be filed not later than 5 p.m. of the day designated; however, any report postmarked by the United States Postal Service no later than midnight of the day designated is deemed to have been filed in a timely manner. Any report received by the filing officer within 5 days after the designated due date that was delivered by the United States Postal Service is deemed timely filed unless it has a postmark that indicates that the report was mailed after the designated due date. A certificate of mailing obtained from and dated by the United States Postal Service at the time of mailing, or a receipt from an established courier company, which bears a date on or before the date on which the report is due, suffices as proof of mailing in a timely manner.



Dear Ms. Pacheco,

You have failed to file the 2021-G3 Campaign Treasurer's Report by the due of October 29, 2021 for the reporting period of October 16, 2021 to October 28, 2021, and a fine is being assessed for each late day. You have been provided with the City of Hialeah 2021 Election Important Dates and deadlines, which includes the dates all Campaign Treasurer's Reports are due.

Your 2021-G3 Campaign Treasurer's Report was delivered to our office on November 1, 2021 at 11:06 a.m.by Yuri Yanes on your behalf.

Pursuant to § 106.07 (8)(b) of the Florida Statutes, the reports immediately preceding each special primary election, special election, primary election, and general election, the fine is \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

The fine is not an allowable campaign expenditure, and must be paid only from your personal funds.

However, you have reported having received a total of \$1,000 in monetary contributions during the period covered by the late report, and having spent a total of \$411.58 in expenditures during the period covered by the late report. Therefore, the total amount of the fine being assed is \$250.00.

You may appeal the fine to the Florida Elections Commission based upon, but not limited to, unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date. In order to request an appeal, you must notify me in writing, within twenty (20) days after receipt of notice of payment due, of your intention to bring the matter before the Florida Elections Commission.

The Florida Division of Elections has opined that the calculation of late days begins on the day after the Campaign Treasurer's Report is due, including weekends and holidays, and continues and includes the date of the postmark, courier receipt, or certificate of mailing, whichever is earlier.

Important Information about Filing Campaign Treasurer's Reports

CANDIDATES MUST ALSO REFER TO THE 2019 CANDIDATE AND CAMPAIGN TREASURER HANDBOOK AND FLORIDA STATUTES CHAPTER 106 FOR ADDITIONAL CAMPAIGN FINANCE GUIDELINES

Florida Statutes § 106.07 and § 106.141

Filing Campaign Treasurer's Reports

Candidates shall file all campaign treasurer's reports with the City Clerk. Candidates must report all contributions and expenditures on required campaign finance reporting forms. The City Clerk shall provide each candidate and campaign treasurer with the appropriate reporting forms.

Campaign treasurer's reports must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, on or by the report's designated due date. A United States postmark bearing the due date or an earlier date is acceptable. Campaign treasurer's reports must be filed at designated intervals (see the reporting calendar). Depending upon when a candidate files his/her "Form DS-DE 9 – Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository" with the City Clerk, reports will be filed monthly, then on the 25th, 11th and 4th days preceding the City of Hialeah Primary Election. The candidate and campaign treasurer or deputy treasurer shall collectively certify the accuracy and truthfulness of each report filed with the City Clerk.

Waiver of Campaign Treasurer's Report

During a reporting period with no campaign finance activity, i.e., no contributions received and funds expended or received, the filing of the report may be waived by notifying the City Clerk that no activity has occurred. The notification shall be made by filing a Waiver of Campaign Treasurer's Report form on or before the report's designated due date. A candidate may mail or file the form in person. A United States postmark bearing the due date or an earlier date is acceptable. The Waiver of Report must be signed by both the candidate and treasurer or deputy treasurer.

Penalties for Filing a Late Report

A late report is subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late, and thereafter, \$500.00 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent (25%) of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For a report that is due immediately preceding the municipal regular election, the fine shall be \$500.00 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent (25%) of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

The City Clerk has no statutory authority to waive a fine. Only the Florida Elections Commission may waive a fine based on a timely appeal filed by the candidate. The Florida Elections Commission shall meet and hold a hearing to determine if a fine shall be waived.

Deadline to Accept Campaign Contributions

Florida Statutes § 106.08

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The deadline for candidates with opposition in the November 2, 2021 City of Hialeah Primary Election to accept campaign contributions is THURSDAY, October 28, 2021. Contributions received after October 28, 2021 must be returned to the contributor.

Form DS DE 2 – *Contributions Returned* is required for disclosing contributions that are not deposited in the campaign account and are returned to the contributor. Form DS-DE 2 will be provided to the candidate and campaign treasurer by the City Clerk.

AN EXPLANATION REGARDING YOUR RIGHTS

Section 2-11.1.1(D)(2) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, provides that any candidate for public office in Miami-Dade County may at any time *voluntarily* declare that he or she agrees to abide by the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices. In agreeing to abide by the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices, as compulsory, the authority of the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust to decide whether the candidate has violated the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices and, if so, to impose the appropriate penalty, if any.

Before agreeing to abide by the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices, you should carefully read the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices included with this DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER as well as the following information regarding your rights.

The Statement of Fair Campaign Practices is *voluntary*. You are under no obligation to agree to the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices. If you decide not to agree to the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices, you may still run for elective office in Miami-Dade County if you are qualified. There is NO PENALTY if you decide not to sign the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices.

If you decide to agree to the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices, you should know that you will be WAIVING YOUR FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS TO FREE SPEECH because certain speech prohibited by the *voluntary* Statement of Campaign Practices is protected by the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and Article I, Section 4, of the Florida Constitution. Prior to agreeing to comply with the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices, you should consider consulting an attorney to ensure that you understand the consequences of signing the DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER.

Before signing this DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER, you have the right to request and receive from the Ethics Commission an advisory opinion as to whether your planned campaign activities (e.g., campaign advertisement or statements) are likely to violate the *voluntary* Statement of Fair Campaign Practices. In the event that you sign the DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER, you will continue to have the right to request and receive from the Ethics Commission an advisory opinion regarding any future campaign activities that you may be considering.

A determination by a candidate not to execute the DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER shall not be construed by Miami-Dade County or the Ethics Commission to mean that the candidate is unethical in any way. Further, a determination by a candidate not to execute the DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER should not be construed by any candidate or any other person or entity to mean that the candidate is unethical in any way.

DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER FOR CANDIDATES WHO AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THE VOLUNTARY STATEMENT OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

VOLUNTARY STATEMENT OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES

As a candidate for public office in Miami-Dade County, I believe that political issues can be freely debated without appealing to racial, ethnic, religious, sexual, or other prejudices. I recognize that such negative appeals serve only to divide this community and create long-term moral, social, and economic problems. Therefore,

I will not permit any member of my campaign organization to engage in these activities and will immediately and publicly repudiate the support of any other individual or group that resorts to the methods and tactics I condemn.
- 7. I shall run a positive campaign emphasizing my qualifications for office and positions on issues of public concern.
- 8. I will limit my attacks on an opponent to legitimate challenges to that person's record, qualifications, and positions.
- 9. I will neither use nor permit the use of malicious untruths or innuendoes about an opponent's personal life, nor will I make or condone unfounded accusations discrediting that person's credibility.
- 10. I will take personal responsibility for approving or disavowing the substance of attacks on my opponent that may come from third parties supporting my candidacy.
- 11. I will not use or permit the use of campaign material that falsifies, distorts, or misrepresents facts.

BY SIGNING THIS DECLARATION AND FIRST AMENDMENT WAIVER, I AGREE TO

- ABIDE BY THE VOLUNTARY STATEMENT OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES,
- SUBMIT TO THE COMPULSORY JURISDICTION OF THE ETHICS COMMISSION, AND
